Bank Account Balance as of 6/16/23: \$3696.43

Includes \$714 donated thus far to Senior Student Award

Goal: Raise \$300 in donations and member dues by end of June

 Allows SPCA to start next fiscal year with \$3000 in the bank after paying the \$1000 Senior Student Award (to be presented at the high school graduation)
